

Euro Indie Film Fest Official Rules

1. Eligibility

- All films must have a clear connection to music, whether through themes, soundtrack, or focus on the musical culture or artists.

- Films containing excessive vulgarity or offensive content will not be accepted.

- All film genres are welcome as long as they adhere to the music-related theme.

2. Submission Guidelines

- Films must be submitted by the deadline specified on the festival's official website.

- Each submission must include the completed registration form and all required media files.

- By submitting a film, the filmmaker agrees to the public screening of their work if selected for the festival.

3. Judging Process

- Films will be evaluated based on five main categories:

1. Cinematography

2. Soundtrack

3. Editing

4. Screenwriting

5. Artistic Interpretation

- Each category will be scored from 1 to 10 by a panel of judges.

- The top 10 films with the highest total scores will advance to the final round.

4. Bonus Categories

- In addition to the main categories, bonus points (from 1 to 3) will be awarded for exceptional performance in the following five areas:

1. Innovation - Films that demonstrate a unique or groundbreaking approach to filmmaking or storytelling.

2. Cultural Impact - Films that highlight or explore significant cultural themes, especially related to music.

3. Use of Visual Effects - Exceptional use of digital or practical effects to enhance the narrative.

4. Sound Design - Outstanding use of sound effects, ambient audio, or dialogue that enhances the film's atmosphere.

5. Human Connection - Films that effectively evoke empathy, highlight the human experience, and build a deep emotional connection with the audience.

5. Category Awards

- In addition to the top 10 finalists, the best film in each of the five main categories (Cinematography, Soundtrack,

Editing, Screenwriting, and Artistic Interpretation) will qualify for the final and receive a special award.

7. Awards

- The winner of the Euro Indie Film Fest will receive a special award and international recognition with the broadcast of

their film on Euro Indie Music Chart TV.

- Additional category-specific awards will also be presented.

8. General Conditions

- The festival reserves the right to disqualify any film that does not meet the submission criteria or is deemed inappropriate.
- The festival's decisions are final and binding.
